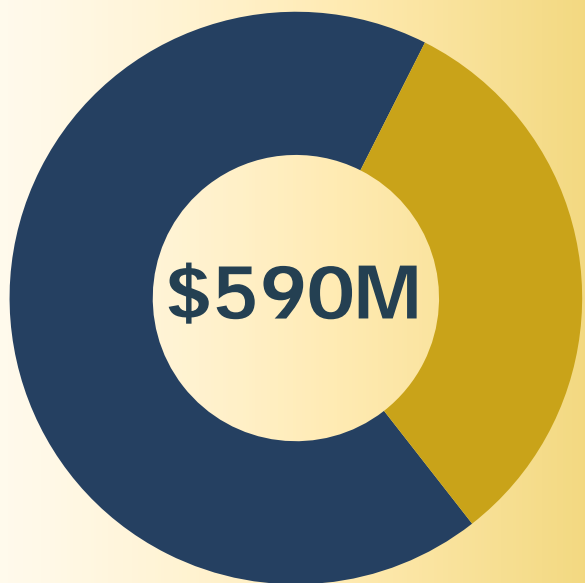
Barrick in the Dominican Republic

Pueblo Viejo

- Joint venture between Barrick (60%) and Goldcorp (40%)
- Operational since 2013
- Produced 572,000 ounces of gold in 2015 (60% basis)
- Accounted for 9% of Barrick's total production
- All-In Sustaining Costs = \$597/ounce
- Reserves¹: 9 million ounces (60% basis)
- 4,415 employees and contractors
- Pueblo Viejo is expected to achieve ISO 14001 certification in 2016
- Cyanide Code certified



Barrick's Economic Investment in the Dominican Republic

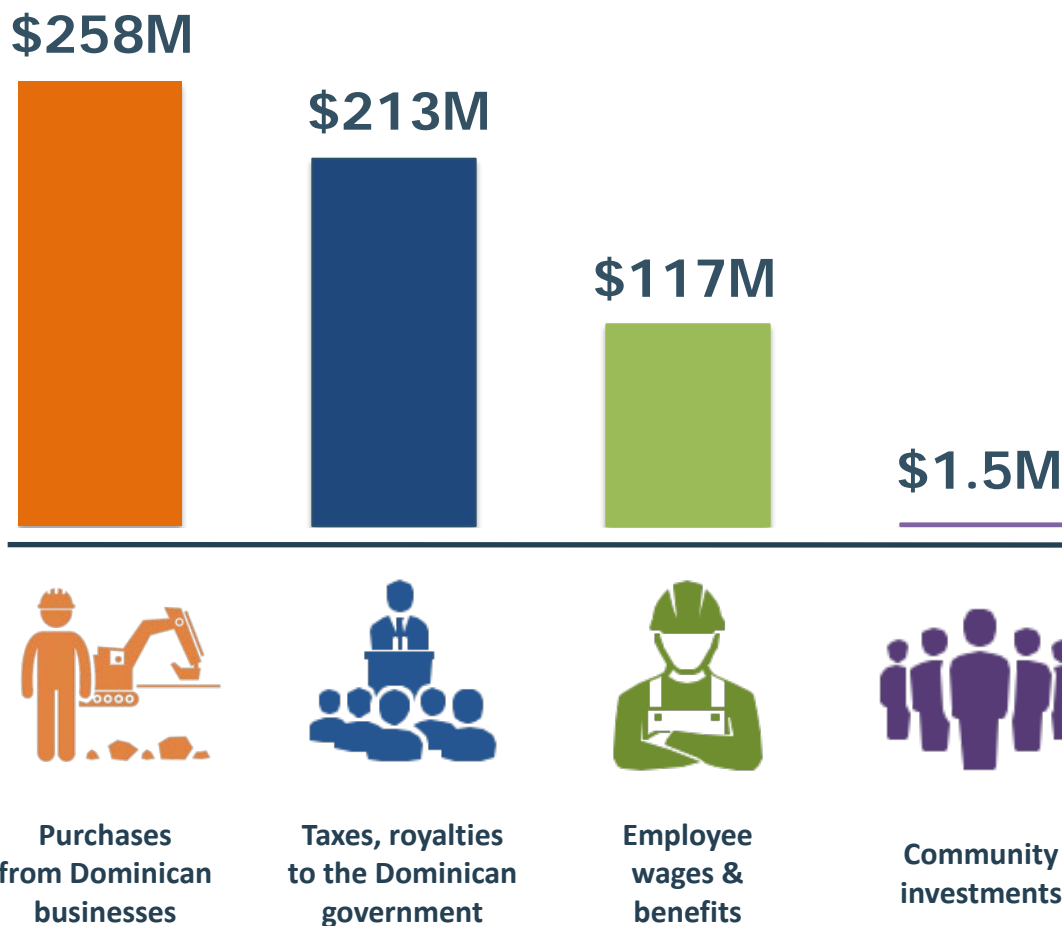


68% of our spending stayed in the Dominican Republic in 2015, an increase from 61% in 2014

In 2012, 90 percent of the Dominican Republic's foreign direct investment to the mining sector came from Barrick.

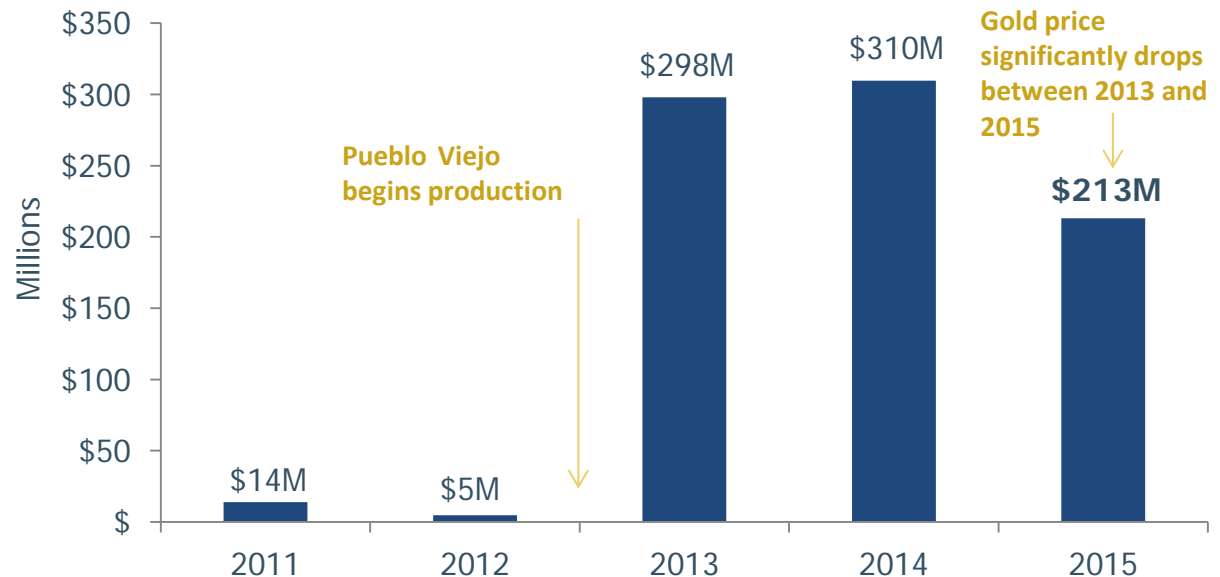

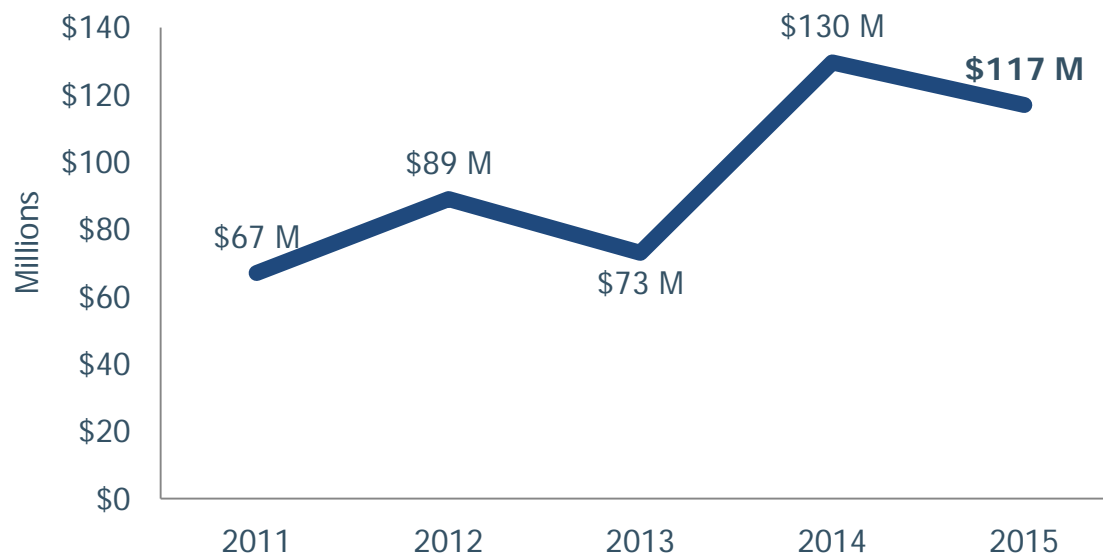
